## Darrell HoltClassic C hallenge Rules and Reg ulations

## 1. SCOPE

These Rules will apply for the conduct and control of the Darrell Holt Classic Challenge and related matters. In the event of any Zone rule conflicting with these rules, then these rules will take precedence.
2. NAME

The toumament will be known as the Darrell Holt Classic Challenge ("the Toumament')
3. PURPOSE

The purpose of the toumament is to:
a. Detemine annually the best Zone representative team of bowlers in a scratch competition with averages not exceeding
i. 199 for male bowlers
ii. 189 for female bowlers
b. Foster, develop, and advance a spinit of good sportsmanship and fellowship, and promote and maintain a good relationship amongst the representative teams
4. ZONES TO BE REPRESENIED
a. Participation in the touma ment will be limited to one team from each of the following a reas of Australia, plus one additional invitational team:
i. North Queensland
ii. South Queensland
iii. New South Wales
iv. Victoria
v. Ta sma nia
vi. South Australia
vii. Westem Australia
viii. The Australian Capital Temitory
ix. The Northem Temitory
5. EIGIBILTY of TEAM MEMBERS
a. Each person must:
i. Be a financial member of a Tenpin Bowling Australia Licensed Association or Registered Bowling Centre, in good standing
ii. Have attained the age of 18 years on, or prior to, the first day of the toumament in that year
iii. Be capable of conducting themselves in such a mannerso as not to discredit either the zone they are representing, or the sport of tenpin bowling
b. Each competitor must:
i. Have competed in a minimum of eight (8) weeks of league competition during the current year, consisting of a minimum of twenty-four (24) games, in a league in a registered centre within the Zone they wish to represent.

1. League gamescompleted as eithera "prebowl" or "postbowl" will not be counted towardsthe minimum requirements
ii. Not have any league average, including touring leagues, over a minimum of 24 games at the end of any league season in the preceding yearexceeding the maximum averages listed under rule 3.a
iii. Continue league play in a league in a registered centre within the Zone they are representing. Bowlers attaining membership via the draft are exempt from this cla use, however must still continue league play in their local respective leagues
iv. Unless granted exemption, be resident within the Zone for the period of time that enables them to participate in the respective selection trials or process, from the commencement of the selection process.
2. Exemption may be granted to players wishing to represent a Zone that is different to the Zone of their residence at the time of trials, upon application in writing to the Toumament Committee
3. Bowlers requesting an exemption must be able to demonstrate that they bowl all, or a major proportion, of their competitive bowling in the Zone they wish to represent
4. Once an exemption has been granted, the bowler must bowl for that Zone. Failure to represent that Zone will result in the bowlers withdrawal from the toumament
v. Have entered into an "All Events" entry in the current year's Da rell Holt Tenpin Bowling Camival ("the camival"), prior to the commencement of the toumament.
5. Note that the "All Events" entry may be completed at any time during the current years Camival, including after the toumament.
6. Abuse of this rule may result in suspension from future years and other sanctions as determined by the Toumament Committee
7. TEAM OPTCIALS

Each zone is limited to two (2) team officials, of a ny combination
a. Team coaches are not required to be accredited under the national accreditation scheme
7. SEIECTION OF TEAMS

Teams will be selected by the respective Zone Association or Committee
a. Determining additional eligibility criteria is the sole responsibility of the respective Zone Association.
i. Any appea ls or compla ints a ga inst non-selection or eligibility criteria set by a Zone Association must be lodged with that Zone Association for resolution
b. Selection must be by way of roll-off, where the first three (3) male bowlers and first three (3) female bowlers will be declared the representative team ("the team") for that zone to compete in the toumament.
i. Positions for the roll-off will be determined by scratch pinfall, with the highest claiming the first position
ii. Each zone is to conduct the roll-off over a single weekend, bowling seven (7) games one the first day and a furtherseven (7) games on the second day
iii. The roll-off may be conducted in conjunction with the equivalent rolloff for the Da rrell Holt Restricted Challenge team, such that bowlers may nominate for, and have their scores used for, both teams if they are eligible.
c. The roster of players for each team in the toumament will not exceed a combined total of six (6) players, comprising of no more than three (3) men and three (3) women.
d. Each Zone Committee must advise the Toumament Committee no later than fourteen (14) days after the completion of that Zones' roll-offs, the names and details of their Team Members.
i. Team registration is to be accompanied by a deposit of five hundred dollars (\$500).
ii. This payment will be credited towards the final team registration invoice and will be used to purchase pre-event medallions, plaques a nd a ny other pre-event expenses.
e. The highest placed male qualifier and the highest placed female qualifier in each Zone will eam the right to be the Classic Masters representative at the c urrent years' ca mival, subject to those bowlers meeting the eligibility requirements set forth in that event.
i. Should a representative be ineligible, unable, or unwilling to represent their Zone at the Classic Masters, the next highest placed bowler of the same gender shall be offered the right, until a bowler is confimed for the position
ii. The fee for this entry will be included in the Zone's registration invoice

## 8. VENUE

The toumament will be conducted at a centre as nominated and selected at the previous year's organization committee's Annual General Meeting
9. CONTROLOF MATCHES

The Touma ment Committee will appoint the principal Touma ment Director who will be responsible for all Toumament preparations and conduct of the matches whilst in progress. The Touma ment Committee may appoint orengage such assistance as deemed necessary to ensure the successful conduct of the toumament

## 10. FORMATFOR MATCHES

a. All play will be conducted on a scratch basis
b. Each player in each tea must compete in a minimum of nine (9) games over the duration of the toumament. Failure to observe this requirement will incura penalty of 2.5 points pergame, perbowler, in breach of this requirement
i. Teams unable to fulfill this requirement for legitimate exceptional circ umstances such as injury or illness may apply to the toumament committee immediately for exemption. The toumament committee will determine the legitimacy of the exceptional circumstances and may wa ive, or reduce, the penalty at its absolute discretion
c. Teams will bowl two complete rounds of matches over the duration of the toumament
i. One complete round shall consist of a sufficient number of matches as to allow each team to play each other team once.
ii. In the event of an uneven number of tea ms competing

1. The toumament committee shall determine the number of matches.
2. The touma ment committee may introduce a "bye" team
d. In the event of a team enjoying a bye, or an individual bowler enjoying a vacant opponent,, the points shall be available as follows
i. Individual male bowlers must score a minimum of 185 to win their point
ii. Individual female bowlers must score a minimum of 175 to win their point
iii. The team must score a minimum of 720 to win their point
e. Teams unable to field a legal line-up due to legitimate exceptional circ umstances may apply to the toumament committee forpermission to fill the team with eligible bowlers. The toumament committee will detemmine the legitimacy of the exceptional circumstances, a nd may or may not grant permission for replacement bowlers.
f. The team scheduled to play on the left hand side lane of the pair used in a match will be obliged to post their order of players first, thus enabling the team scheduled for the right hand side lane to match-up their players against the line-up posted
g. Only bowlers of the same gender may compete "Head to Head" in any given team match.
i. The order in which the genders appear in the line-up will be determined by the team on the left ha nd side lane, when posting their line-up
h. In the event that a player must withdraw during a game due to legitimate c irc umstances, a nother member of the team may replace that bowler in the line-up under the following;
i. The replacement player must be of the same gender asthe original player
ii. The score bowled will be credited to the original player
iii. The touma ment committee will determine the legitimacy of the circumstances, and may not permit the replacement at its absolute discretion

## 11. POINTS SYSTEM

Points in the touma ment will be a warded as follows;
a. Individual bowlers will be matched against the bowler in the same position of the opposing teams' line-up. The bowler with the higher scratch score shall be awarded one (1) point. In the event of a tie, the point will be equally shared
b. Each team will be matched against the team on the opposing lane of the pair that the match is conducted on. The team with the higher scratch total shall be awarded two (2) points. In the event of a tie, the points will be equally shared
c. At the conclusion of both rounds of matc hes, the team having the highest number of points will be declared the Champion Team for the current year.

## 12. DRESS RULES

Dress rules will a pply to the toumament
a. All bowlers within a team must wear a collared shirt of the same design.
b. All bowlers within a team must wear one of the following;
i. Dress slacks
ii. Dress shorts
iii. Skirts (La dies only)
c. Private sponsorship may be displayed on the sleeves of the shirt only, subject to the sponsorship being approved as per rule 13

## 13. SPONSORSHIP

All partic ipating tea ms are required to submit to the toumament committee, a ny proposed team or individual sponsorship. This requirement is to detemine that there will be no conflict with current or proposed sponsorship agreements with the toumament, such as with the venue or extemal sponsors

## 14. AWARDING OF THE TROPHY

a. The Darrell Holt Classic Challenge Trophy will be presented to the captain of the Champion Team immediately after the toumament
i. The Trophy is a perpetual trophy a nd will remain the property of the Da rell Holt Committee
ii. The Zone represented by the Champion Team will be permitted to hold the Trophy, for display throughout that Zone at the disc retion of that Zone's Association
iii. The Zone acting ascustodian to the Trophy will retum it prior to the next scheduled commencement of the toumament
b. Placings will be allocated to teams based on total points won, with tea ms of equal points being ordered by total scratch pinfall
i. In the event of a tie for first placing, a play-off will be bowled.

1. When only two teams are involved in such play-off, the format will be as per the format for a single match.
2. The lanes used for any play-off ortie-break match will be decided by the toumament committee
3. The starting lanes for tea ms partic ipating in any play-off or tiebreak match will be determined by a "Toss of a Coin", with the team on higherscratch pinfall having "the Call"
4. The team that accumulates the most points will be declared the Champion Team. If a tie still exists, the process shall be repeated as necessary
5. If more than two teamsare involved in such play-off, the format will be determined by the toumament committee

## 15. MEDAШONS

Gold, Silver, and Bronze medallions will be presented to First, Second, and Third placed teams respectively. A maximum of eight (8) medallions will be distributed per team
16. ADDITIONALY TROPHES

The following individual trophies will be a warded;

## a. SPORISPERSON AWARD

All team members will be invited to cast votes for the Male or Female Sportsperson of the year. The Sportsperson should be the Male and Female bowlers who, in the opinion of their peers, demonstrated best the values for which the toumament is run
i. Voting slips will be distributed to each team, during the moming of each day.
ii. Voting slips will be retrieved from each team, at the conclusion of the ga me after they a re distributed
iii. Bowlers must not vote for a bowler on their own team. Such votes will be removed from the tally and not counted
iv. The bowler receiving the most votes from the peers will be declared the winner of the award, one foreach Male and Female
v. The touma ment committee have the right of veto over the voting, however they may not arbitrarily appoint a victor
b. CHAIRMAN'S and SEC REIARY'S AWARDS

These special a wards will be presented to bowlers who have impressed the
Chaiman and the Secretary over the course of the toumament
i. The Chairman's award will be awarded to a Male bowler
ii. The Secretary's award will be awarded to a Female bowler
iii. Criteria taken into consideration when selecting these a wards will include, but not be limited to, points won, games played, event average, and pins over average
c. TEAM OF THE YEAR

At the conclusion of the toumament, a "Team of the Year" ("the team") will be announced. This team represents the best bowlers of the event, from across all tea ms involved in the touma ment
i. To be eligible for the team, bowlers must have completed a minimum of two thirds (2/3) of the games during the toumament
ii. The best two (2) eligible Male bowlers based on scratch average will be the Male component of the team
iii. The best two (2) eligible Female bowlers based on scratch average will be the Female component of the team
iv. In the event of a tie for the last position in the team, the following criteria will determine the bowler who will occupy this position;

1. The bowler with the higherexact scratch average to two (2) decimal places will take the position
2. The bowler who played more games during the toumament
3. The bowlerwho has accumulated the most points during the toumament
